



## AS9100D:2016 and AS9120B:2016 Status and Transition Planning

The AS9100D – 2016 revision was released on September 20, 2016 and the AS9120B – 2016 revision was released on November 1, 2016. Companies currently certified to AS9100C or AS9120A are required to transition to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B revision by September 15, 2018 (Note all aerospace audits after June 15, 2017 must be to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B revision of the standard). The IAQG has published Supplemental Rules SR-003 dated October 12, 2016 detailing the requirements for transitioning to the new revisions of the Aerospace Standard(s). A copy of the latest revision of SR-003 has been attached below. SR003 is the document that provides guidance and rules for companies transitioning to the new AS9100D and AS9120B standards. It also defines requirements for the Accreditation Bodies (ANAB), Certification Bodies like MCNA, and aerospace auditors to comply with. SR003 is issued by the International Aerospace Quality Group (IAQG) Other Party Management Team (OPMT) and provides several key milestone dates for the transition process. Aerospace certified companies need to be aware of the requirements and deadlines to ensure a timely transition to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B Standard. Below is a listing of some of key dates that will affect your certification and transition over the next two years.

### Key Milestones

- **September 20, 2016** – AS9100D published.
- **November 1, 2016** – AS9120B 2016 published.
- **February 2017** – MCNA *expects* to begin conducting audits to these new standards.
- **March 1, 2017** – certified organizations to AS9100C and 9120A must communicate to MCNA an intended date for AS9100D / AS9120B AQMS standard transition readiness.
- **June 15, 2017**– All Initial, Surveillance, and Recertification audits starting after June 15, 2017 ***must be*** to the newest versions of the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B standard.
- **December 1 2017**- MCNA shall have completed a risk and mitigation analysis for all clients that have not transitioned to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B standard.
- **July 15, 2018** – All transition audits to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B standard for existing MCNA clients are to be completed by this date.
- **September 1, 2018** – The transition audit report, associated documentation and closed NCR's (if any) must be received by MCNA.
- **September 15, 2018**– Certification decisions for all transition audits to the applicable AS9100D and AS9120B standard must be made by MCNA by this date. If not, the applicable certification will no longer be eligible for transition and an initial certification audit (Stage 1 / Stage 2) will be required.

Per SR003 additional audit time will be required to complete the transition audit. This additional time may be added to your regularly scheduled surveillance or recertification audit or may be scheduled as a special audit.
